



My Driving Practice Guide and DMV Drive Test Tips

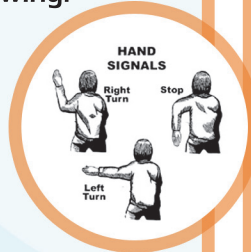
Here are some useful reminders and tips to help you pass your DMV drive test. Parents, you can use this as a guide when practicing with your kids for the required 50 hrs, 10 of which are at night.

Pre-Drive Test

First things first: Make sure you know where they're located and how to use all of the following:

- Horn
- Headlights
- Parking Brake
- Windshield Wipers
- Hazard Lights
- Front Window Defroster



And don't forget your hand-signals!

Automatic Fails

Don't want to get disqualified? Then these are the things you don't want to do on test day:

- Examiner intervention
- Disobey sign or signal
- Dangerous maneuver
- Lane violation (don't drift)
- Speeding (know the speed limit!)
- Strike an object (don't hit that curb!)
- Auxiliary equipment (brake lights, turn signals, etc.)



Areas to Practice, Practice, Practice!

Want to pass the DMV drive test on your first try? Make sure you're doing all of the driving maneuvers below according to the DMV handbook and CA Vehicle Code:

Right and Left Turns

- Steering control (too wide/short)
- Safe speed (10-12mph)
- Signal (100 ft before)
- Traffic check (SMOG)
- Finish in correct lane



Bike Lanes before Right Turns

- You must merge into bike lane before right turn
- Merge when bike lane line becomes broken
- Always SMOG to the right before merging
- Yield to any cyclists already in the bike lane

Lane Changes

- Signal, mirror, over the shoulder (SMOG)
- Maintain appropriate speed
- Don't cut anyone off

At Stop Signs & Stop Lights

- Smooth, complete stop
- Traffic checks (rear-view mirror too)
- Behind limit line/crosswalk



When Driving Straight

- Scanning entire road
- Use your mirrors every 2-5 seconds
- Watch your speed!
- Safe spacing w/ moving and parked cars



Through Intersections

- Traffic checks BEFORE intersection
- Cover brake

Curb-side Parking

- Signal, mirror, over the shoulder (SMOG) (going to & pulling away from curb)
- Within 18" of curb (but don't hit curb!)

Backing in Straight Line

- Keep straight without hitting curb
- Look behind you as you reverse
- Don't back into traffic



Around Curves

- Slow into curve & stay on the right side of the road

6. Make sure person taking you to test has a valid driver license.
